

Where to stay off-campus?

Nice places to stay near the Reed campus are hard to find. Here are some options:

1) The Avalon:

a VERY nice hotel a short drive away, right on the Willamette river. Some of the rooms are very expensive but they sometimes run \$99 specials too.

2) This place is near 35th and SE Division, a short drive away from Reed College campus. Pictures on their website. It looks like they're booked for the relevant days but you could ask about cancellations. This would be the most conveniently located place I can find that isn't like a Motel 6 or a hostel.

4) The Rivershore is a Best Western hotel a little south of Reed. Maybe 20 minutes drive to campus. Good location if you want to avoid downtown.

Downtown hotels: any of these would be nice places and convenient to the downtown attractions:

A little less expensive but still nice: Hotel DeLuxe on SW 15th, The Days Inn at SW 6th and Market, Northrup Station in NW section of town on Northrup street (a bit longer commute)

Near the Convention ctr on the east side (North of Reed) there is a Red Lion and a Holiday Inn. In good traffic maybe 15 minutes to Reed, but check what's happening at the convention ctr - It might be crazy on the days you want. Lion And The Rose B And B in Portland, Oregon: 1810 Northeast 15th Avenue, Portland, OR 97212. Nice but small, may be booked up.
